## MINUTES OF THE EXTRAORDINARY MEETING OF GLYNDE & BEDDINGHAM PARISH COUNCIL HELD AT 7PM ON WEDNESDAY 20<sup>th</sup> APRIL 2022 AT THE READING ROOM, GLYNDE.

GB2122-111	<b>1. Public Question and Statements</b> 1 member of the public joined the meeting.
GB2122-112	<b>2. Acceptance of apologies for absence</b> Apologies received, and noted, from Cllr Gribble and Cllr Jolley.
GB2122-113	<b>3. Declarations of Interest</b> Cllr Pratley declared an interest as a member of the pool committee (Membership Secretary)
GB2122-114	<b>4. Glynde Swimming Pool</b> The Chair suspended standing orders and invited Ms Bente Klein, treasurer of Glynde Community Swimming Pool Committee, to speak. Ms Klein explained that the pool committee are in the process of setting up a Community Interest company who will enter a service agreement with the Parish Council. Cllr Denis has spoken to ESALC to request advice from ESALC solicitors and is waiting for a conversation and a quote. Cllr Denis requested to be granted delegated powers to proceed with the organisation of the agreement between the Parish Council and the pool committee. Cllr Denis will continue to update the Parish Council on progress made with the agreement. It was <b>RESOLVED</b> to grant delegated powers for Cllr Denis to proceed with the organisation of a service agreement with the Community Interest Company.

It was <b>RESOLVED</b> to grant delegated powers for Cllr Denis to proceed by making contact with available clerks regarding the locum role.

Cllr Sadler requested that the Cricket Club are approached and offered the work before we select a grass cutting company. It was <b>RESOLVED</b> that the Clerk will contact the Cricket Club with regards to the grass cutting work.
